

Thoughts? Also, would it do me any good to install to my sata drive on VMWare and then add the kernel (does VM ware support a 'virtual' drive?) and then make the drive bootable? Any help is appreciated. - unless to the dhd image if that does not work, I'll just plug it into my intel board and run a quick install there then move it over. The only problem that I could see is that the 10.4.9 that I have contains the nvidia drivers needed for AMD. I have the SIL314 (IBRC) and I wanted to know if there was any way to add the kernel to the boot DVD. I remember being able to change the OAHPSM file in the hd-04.dmg or 10.4.9. It involved using hdiutil and mounting as a read/write file system. I'm trying to finalize my install on this thing jones! You can install to another more compatible machine and then plug these drivers in the osx4all you can just plug the hd into the amd machine and it will work! OSX is not hardware dependent as is windows! OK, well, I am going to 'TRY' to make a dhd using mkextmpack command and applying the new Extensions.
